1 Urine Collection Bottle

Information

It is essential that urine specimens are carefully collected for accurate laboratory results. Please follow the instructions **exactly**. If you are unsure how to collect the specimen, ask our staff to explain.

Collection Instructions

1. Empty your bladder into the toilet soon after getting out of bed in the morning and record the time (eg. 7.00am) and date on the bottle.
2. From now on collect every drop of urine you pass day or night for 24Hrs and pour into the bottle supplied.

We strongly advise that you avoid the contents of the bottle and suggest that you first collect your urine into another container (eg. ice cream container) and then pour into the bottle.

3. Next morning empty your bladder at exactly the same time as above and pour into the bottle supplied. Record the time and date of collection. This completes the collection.
4. The bottle should be kept in a cool place.
5. Bring container to the Collection Centre as soon as possible after finishing the collection.

Please note that if any urine is accidentally lost/spilt you must notify the collector when returning the sample.
